This is a residential complex designed for the Saudi royal family on the shores of the Red Sea. Commissioned by HRH Aljohara Bin Faisal Bin Turki Bin Abdullah Al Saud, this complex of buildings is requested as an integrated resort on the site and with environmental criteria.

The distribution and size of the spaces are in accordance with the needs to combine the family life with receiving personalities and friends, and the management of the activities of the members of the royal household.

A central avenue structure and links the zones from the entrance to the private beach with chill out areas, wide promenades, a pool in the sea, and a pier with a fishing area.

Several villas are designed: for the family, for prince, for daughters, one for the direct collaborators and four guest houses, in addition of some houses for service and security. The privacy between the buildings is achieved by plant barriers and meandering walls.

The climatic conditions required to create a place prepared to deal with the high temperatures and the sandstorms. The roofs will be covered by grease plants and in the gardens design highlight the green slopes, water and a large variety of plants.
