## INTERIOR DESIGN VISITORS CENTER TORRES WINERIES

BC Estudio Architects has carried out the project to enlarge the current building of the visitor center of the Bodegas Torres winery . The new building is composed of two floors with an architectural program, addressed to all of those visitors who want to enjoy and get knowledge surrounding the world of wine.

The main idea of the project was to avoid the industrial and impersonal aspect of the existing building, seeking to create a pleasant and agreeable environment. The building is completed with a Landscape project that develops around the building and looks over the existing field of vines.

On the ground floor, a spacious room is generated with different areas and flowing circulations which allow visitors to access the museum and shop of the adjoining building. The visitors also have a direct access to the exterior spaces and can contemplate the vineyards surrounding the building and have a spectacular view of the multi-peaked Montserrat mountain, which is a symbol of Catalonia.

In the ground floor a large bar acts as a backbone allowing visitors to taste the wide selection of wines and their pairings. Around the room different seating areas favor the tasting of wine in an agreeable environment. The color palette, textures are inspired on the world of wine and surrounding landscape; vegetal textures, hydraulic pavements and vitreous tiles combined with the use of wood, cork and fabrics with earthy tones.

A staircase and elevator give access to the first floor, a large multifunctional room covered by a wooden beam ceiling that can be adapted to different activities .Surrounding this main room there are two private tasting rooms, one with private entrance for VIP guests
