MULTIFUNCTIONAL SPACE FOR BODEGAS TORRES

VILAFRANCA DEL PENEDÉS, BARCELONA, SPAIN

The multifunctional hall is a renovation project of a space located in the basement of the Waltraud cellar, an earlier project built by Bc Estudio Architects for Bodegas Torres.

Three proposals were made .All of them started from the premise to create from an existing space ,various tasting rooms. By using mobile wall panels , up to three tasting separate rooms are generated. These rooms are contained within a larger space with a bar area , a sitting space and an independent tasting room

The natural light comes into the hall by an existing courtyard . Diverse proposals were made inside the curved wall that encloses the room, from a backlit photograph that reproduces the scenery outside to a lighted panel with bottles. The illuminated perimeter walls, are paneled with parchment paper and wooden slats

There are two access to the multifunctional hall, a service access enables access of goods from the exterior road and a vertical circulation element communicates with the upper cellar.
